Global T&C Industry Today

The global textile and clothing industry, weighed down by weak retail environment and constraints in raw material availability, is at a turning point. The business environment in the Western markets is improving slowly with the manufacturing sector in general and the T&C industry in particular, at the threshold of an impressive recovery in India. The industry has to work out effective strategies to reduce the existing irritants in supply chain and enhance the techno economic efficiency of textile production.



India Emerges as an Important Supplier

The slowdown in industrial growth in leading textile consuming countries is leading to an inevitable industry consolidation in Asia. India has emerged as one of the largest suppliers of textile and clothing products to the entire world.

The Indian textile industry's inherent strength in supplying basic raw materials, key inputs like yarn and fabrics and finished products like home textiles and clothing is yet to be explored completely by many textile producing and consuming countries of Asia and the West.

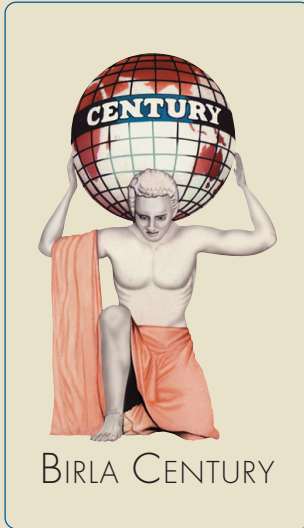
